Children's Services

Early Childhood Services

Early Childhood Mental Health (ECMH) services help parents of children from 0 to 5 years old establish routines and behavioral strategies to address concerns related to aggression, autism, non-compliance, toilet training, and sleeping. In addition to family services, ECMH also provides consultation services to child care providers.

Early Childhood Consultation (ECC) is focused on providing services to parents with history of substance use. Our Early Childhood consultants provide groups and outreach to families to help them continue developing parenting skills.

School-Based Therapy

Through **School-Based Therapy**, licensed staff provide therapy services to school-aged children in Christian, Caldwell, Crittenden, Dawson Springs, Lyon, Todd, and Trigg County schools. Providers are able to help children with clinical concerns,



including depression, anxiety, anger, disruptive behaviors, trauma, identity development, and social interactions.

Youth Treatment Coordination (YTC)

YTC is a service provided for at-risk youth involved in juvenile courts. Our Youth Treatment Coordinator helps children and families in the courts establish mental health services appropriate to their situation.

IMPACT Case Management

IMPACT provides children with severe emotional disabilities additional support in their homes and communities. Children are assigned an IMPACT Service Coordinator to help clients and their parents navigate services and community support. Coordinators establish connections between services for better overall care.

Transition Age Youth Coordination (TAY)

The **TAY Coordinator** helps bridge the gap between children's services and adult services. They work alongside transition-age youth to identify barriers and ways to improve the transition process. TAY is also responsible for working alongside internal and external services to provide training on reducing these barriers.

Youth Peer Support Services

Youth Peer Support Specialists use their lived experiences to help children and families obtain and utilize services. They can help families advocate for the services they need and encourage them throughout the process.



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
