YOUR UNIQUE PATHWAY.

There are many pathways to recovery. Our staff are uniquely trained to partner with you, your family, and other members of your healthcare team. We will create a 12-step facilitated plan for recovery based on your specific needs. We utilize Hazelden Betty Ford Foundation's COR-12 model, an evidence-based approach that combines the use of specific medications and other types of behavioral and talk therapy.

Your pathway may include:

- **Medical and recovery support care** from doctors, advanced practice nurses, therapists, case managers, and peer support specialists who are specially trained in substance use disorders.
- **Oral, injectable, and implant medications** for treatment of opioid use disorders and medication treatment of alcohol use disorder.
- **Intensive out-patient, group, individualized therapy**, case management, and peer support services, with a focus on building a foundation of recovery and healing.

Together with the Hazelden Betty Ford Foundation, we offer safe, effective, out-patient treatment customized for your care.

- Medications for treatment of substance use disorder including opioids and alcohol.
- Dual-diagnosis treatment.
